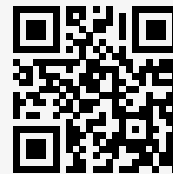

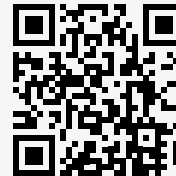

## TEACHERS ROCK

TCC and Wireless Zone stores showed up for teachers in a personal way. In February, each store partnered with a local school in their community. Teams carefully gathered school supplies, turning everyday items into meaningful care kits. Those kits were delivered directly to classrooms, reminding educators that their work is seen, valued, and appreciated.



## RESCUES ROCK

TCC and Wireless Zone stores partnered with local animal rescues to host in-store pet adoption events. Some locations teamed up with Pet Supplies Plus, providing tote bags with coupons, new pet parent checklists, toys, and gift card giveaways. Two rescues received \$10K and one received \$30K for urgent medical needs.



## SCHOOL ROCKS

TCC and Wireless Zone stores handed out free backpacks and school supplies to local students. During the month of June, five school finalists around the country competed to win a bus full of school supplies. The community that collected the most donations received a bus full of supplies, and all 5 finalists received the school supplies collected during their respective drive.



## DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS

We were proud to support More Than a Phone (MTAP), which provides survivors of domestic violence with free smartphones + four months of data. TCC stores collected used devices to support MTAP, and we asked the domestic violence organizations we partner with to submit artwork for our next screen cleaning cloths. The winning design is now sold in all TCC stores, and all proceeds go to MTAP.

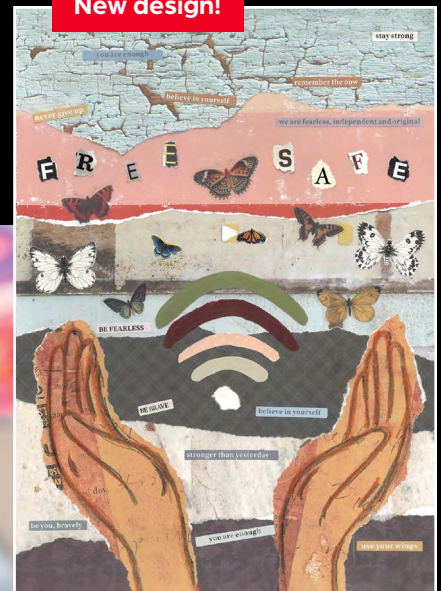

## ROUND UP:

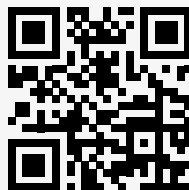
